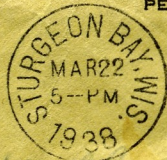

all the scraps & pieces of new goods
embroidery patterns & so forth
the girls & Ella are to have them -
my knitting needles are to be
divided, the ~~table~~ spread goes to
Marie Siler 3 ^{spreads} are to be kept
for Father's bed & go to John at
his death the white covered quilt
& ~~one~~ the one that is on our bed
are to be saved for Father,
about the dishes there is a bid
~~wooden bowl~~, that is to go to Mrs
Joseph Kessier my sister as it
belonged to my mother!
to Marie the round blue roaster
& 6 wine glasses to Marie,
the hand bag is to go to Josephine
or Julia Also Annie's Trunk is
to be taken care of by Marie or
Josephine

Flachoe the double boiler to
Josephine the get together & decide
what you want.
